Sir,

You are aware that Measles is one of the major causes of childhood mortality and morbidity in India. Rubella infection in pregnant women disables a child for life with Congenital Rubella Syndrome that may result in deafness, blindness and heart defects.

Our country is committed to eliminate Measles and control Rubella /Congenital Rubella Syndrome by 2020.

As part of the key elimination strategy, Measles Rubella vaccination campaign is scheduled to be held in West Bengal from 2nd fortnight of November 2018. A successful campaign will involve vaccination of all children of age group 9 months to less than 15 years in all districts and urban areas of the state, and the state government is fully committed to do so. The campaign will be initially school based, followed by community based. Hence active participation and cooperation of school authorities at district level is highly required for successful implementation of the programme.

In this regard I will like to have support of your department on following aspects -

- Providing directives to all Education Department officials of the districts to support the MR vaccination campaign at every level in coordination with health department counterparts.
- Ensuring participation of concerned officers of your department in DTFI /BLTF & District / Block Coordination committee - for smooth coordination & timely resolution of issues.
- Instructing District Education Department officers to sensitize and orient school principals, teachers, parents and students about the importance of MR vaccination campaign in coordination with DIO/CMOH.
- Directing teachers to discuss the beneficial effect of MR vaccine campaign in parent teacher meetings.
- Ensuring participation of all staff of school in effective planning and successful implementation of MR vaccination campaign sessions at schools.

Necessary direction from your end may kindly be issued to the concerned officers for their active participation and support.
